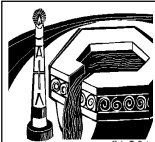

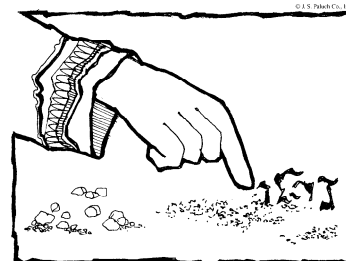

THE YEAR OF FAITH

The word “creed” comes from the Latin word “credere,” which means “to believe.” The creed is a statement of faith, a statement of what we as Catholic Christians believe.

Number 185 in the Catechism of the Catholic Church states, “Whoever says ‘I believe’ says ‘I pledge myself to what we believe.’ Communion in faith needs a common language of faith, normative for all and uniting all in the same confession of faith.”

There are two versions of the Creed: the Apostles’ Creed and the Nicene Creed. The Apostles’ Creed is so named because it gives a faithful summary of the faith handed down by the apostles. This version is typically used during baptisms and when we renew our baptismal promises. The Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed, more commonly known as the Nicene Creed, was developed over time during the first two Ecumenical Councils that took place in Nicea and in Constantinople in the years 325 and 381, respectively.

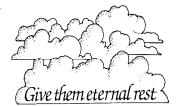

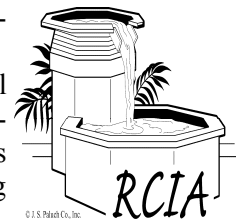

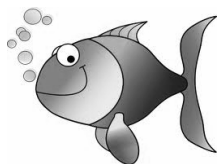

Señales que viven violencia en el noviazgo:

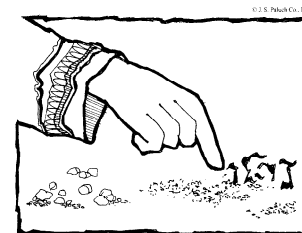
Si el novio o la novia:

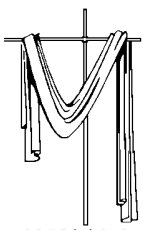

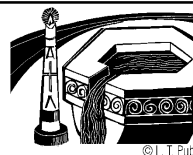
