Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the Children and Youth of OLPH. As a parish we have dreams and hopes for our young disciples – the children and teenagers who participate in the vibrancy of our church. Without a doubt parents have dreams and hopes for their children, which include their religious upbringing. Todd and Michelle Malynn, for example, expressed it this way. While reflecting upon the plans for our new church, they revealed the passion for their children, “Our fear was that time was passing OLPH by – that our Church might not play the role we wanted in our children’s lives.”

Parents want the best for their children. They want Christ and the church to be part of their children’s foundation. This struck me in a profound way early in April while my own family was celebrating my youngest brother’s 50th birthday. My sisters had gathered photos and put together a slide show. One of the first was a photo of my infant brother in the arms of mom and dad who were dressed in their Sunday best and standing with a priest in front of the baptismal font. A little later in the show, we challenged my brother to name all the beaming eight year-old boys dressed in dark pants, white shirts, and bow ties who happened to be in the photo taken in the staging area for his First Holy Communion. There was a picture of the first time that he served mass; and, of course there were photos of the weddings of his older brothers and sisters as well as his own.

So many special moments in life are connected to church. The Malynns like other families in our parish are about to send children off to college. They reasonably expect that our new church will be ready when it’s time for their children to return to OLPH for weddings and maybe even the subsequent baptisms of their grandchildren. If we raise the needed funds during our three-year campaign, we will begin construction and the church will be ready.

Today is a delightful day. It’s a celebration of the Children and Youth at OLPH. They have a place in the church, and don’t we want this for them?



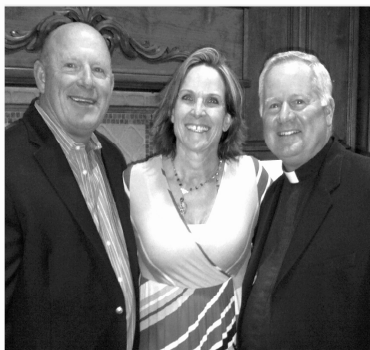
## *Celebrate with the Campaign Team!*

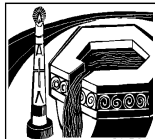

### ADULT FAITH FORMATION

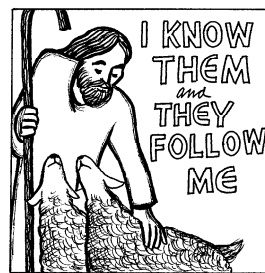

**THE YEAR OF FAITH**

In speaking about Jesus, the third statement in the Apostles' Creed says: "...who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary..."

Why was it necessary for God to take on human flesh and become one of us? Only God has the power to save, and by becoming human, God reconciled us to Himself. Through the Word made flesh, humanity became adopted children of the Father and we became the brothers and sisters of the Son of God. Someone once said that if Jesus was not human, then humanity was not saved; and if Jesus was not God, he did not have the power to save.



YEAR OF FAITH 2012

Incarnation means the taking on of human flesh, and this happened at the moment of conception. By the power of the Holy Spirit the Son of God took on human flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary. Doesn't this show to us just how intimately God wants to be a part

of our lives, that He would become one of us and be as vulnerable as we are? Being both truly God and truly human, this makes Jesus the true mediator between God and humanity, because he is both and fully understands both. Jesus has experienced both divinity and humanity. The first centuries of the Church were dedicated to defending this part of our faith.

Fulfilling the prophecy in Isaiah 7:14, which states "the virgin shall be with child, and bear a son, and shall name him Immanuel," the Blessed Mother gave birth to Jesus while still a virgin. We call Mary the "Mother of God" because we know that Jesus is both God and man.

## TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El 25 de abril la Iglesia conmemora a Pedro de Betancur (1626–1667). Originalmente de las Islas Canarias, a la edad de 24, se trasladó a Cuba. En 1651 llegó a Guatemala con la ambición de predicar a Cristo. Esto lo hizo, no como sacerdote ni religioso. El fue como laico, reconociendo su deber bautismal de evangelizar.

En 1655 ingresó en la Orden Seglar Franciscana y como laico quiso poner en práctica la espiritualidad franciscana, ayudando a los pobres. Sin su propio pan o casa el alimentaba al hambriento y amparaba al indigente. A todos recordaba la necesidad de la salvación y en la simplicidad de su mensaje derretía el egoísmo de los ricos. Les abría el corazón enseñándoles a compartir con los más pequeños de sus hermanos y hermanas.

Eventualmente su nobleza de espíritu atrajo a hombres y mujeres que deseaban compartir su apostolado y fundó la Orden Betlehemita. También fundó la primera escuela de niños en Centro América convirtiéndose en el alfabetizador de Guatemala. Así dio ejemplo de lo que la Iglesia debe hacer por el pobre y marginado.
