Dear Parishioners:

I can only imagine what you all want to know. It has to be the question on your mind. I admit: it's the question on my mind. Cards have been coming to our office by mail every day and many more cards are anticipated in the coming days by mail, in person, and through the offertory in Mass. I'm trusting you will do this and I hope you know how very much I appreciate all you're doing for our parish.

This continues to be a busy and exciting time for our parish. Many of you have worked tirelessly to make our campaign efforts thus far a success. Please know how much I give thanks to God for both the privilege of being your pastor and for your many hours of service and dedication to our parish.

EVENING OF REFLECTION

Master Catechist, Ron Martellino, will be speaking on the Eucharist at this year's Evening of Reflection, sponsored by the St. Joan Women's Guild, on Monday, May 6th, at 7:00 p.m. in the Junipero Serra Conference Room in the Pastoral Center. Ron is an inspiring speaker and everyone is invited to participate in this wonderful, uplifting evening.

The Year of Faith

The fifth statement in the Apostles' Creed says: "...on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead."

Five weeks ago we celebrated Easter. Throughout this season we celebrate Christ's victory over death, in which he promises we will also share. This is about who we are. We are an Easter people; we are a resurrection people. Without the Resurrection, our faith would be nothing. The Resurrection shows Jesus' divine authority and confirms all of his works and teachings. It is because of the Resurrection that we celebrate Mass on Sunday and that we hold each Sunday as the most important holy day of obligation (CCC 2177).

Next Sunday (although normally celebrated on a Thursday) we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. The Ascension completes, in a sense, the plan of salvation in that Jesus in his humanity is now fully glorified at the right hand of the Father, meaning that he has all the glory and honor of divinity. As the Father's "right hand man," we have a powerful intercessor for us who has promised to bring us to the Father's side.

Jesus spoke of the Last Day, or the Day of Judgment. On this day, the conduct of each person and the secrets of our hearts will be revealed and he "will render to each man according to his works and according to his acceptance or refusal of grace (CCC 682).

More of the Church's teaching on this statement from the Creed can be found in the Catechism of the Catholic Church numbers 638-682.

DID YOU KNOW?

Is Your Family Prepared for a Natural Disaster? A news report on last month's earthquake in Southwest China demonstrates how important it is to have a family preparedness plan in case of a disaster. *The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children* offers the following recommendations to all families potentially impacted by a natural disaster: Know where your children are at all times; Stay together; Take photos of your children with you when evacuated; Give children identification information to carry with them, including the child's name, date of birth, address, phone numbers, etc.; E-mail digital photos of all family members to extended relatives and/or friends; Photocopy important documents and mail to a friend/relative in a safe location; Make a plan with your children, so they know what to do if your family becomes separated during an evacuation.
