Dear Parishioners:

Summer is full of longer days. More neighbors seem to be outside. Cooking on the grill happens more frequently. There is a natural draw towards participation in friendship and family. Children tend to participate in summer camp or summer school. The aquatic center or other pools draw young people to participate in swim teams. Participation is an important part of summer.

St. Paul writes, "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?" (1Cor 10:16) The word "participation" literally means "to take part in" or "to share in something." But it also means to possess some of the attributes of a person, thing, or quality. When we receive the bread of life in Holy Communion, we take part or share in the Body of Christ. When we drink from the chalice of salvation, we take part or share in the Blood of Christ. But we also end up possessing the attributes of Jesus Christ. We are nourished with the ability to forgive, the vision of the kingdom, the single mindedness of being one with God and being drawn to do God's will. We discover a new energy to do what it takes to love unconditionally. In short, we become like Christ.

Participation normally enriches our lives. Children benefit from summer camp and summer school. Evening meals with family and friends unify and strengthen bonds between people. The same is true of participation in OLPH.

THE YEAR OF FAITH

As stated in last week's article, Baptism forever marks us as belonging to God, therefore Baptism cannot be repeated (CCC 1272). That means that only an unbaptized person can be baptized. A baptism is done validly with the words "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," and if the baptizing minister has the same intent of baptism that belongs to the Church. There are cases where if the event of the baptism is in doubt, then there is a conditional baptism, where the minister adds before the Trinitarian formula, "If you are not baptized..."

Each baptism requires the use of water, which accompanies with it certain aspects of cleansing and giving life. This also calls to mind what Jesus said in John 3:5, "no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit."

The normal minister of Baptism is a bishop, priest, or deacon. But in the case of necessity, anyone can baptize as long as they have the intention of doing what the Church does and that they pour water on the head of the candidate while saying the Trinitarian baptismal formula, invoking the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit (CCC 1284).

According to Canon Law number 873, "There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor or one of each." The sponsor is someone who is at least sixteen years old and has the responsibility of helping the parents to raise the newly baptized in the faith. For this reason, the sponsor must be a fully initiated Catholic (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) and live in accordance with the teachings of the Church (Code of Canon Law 874) so that they could be a good example of living out the faith consistently and as best as possible.

PRE-BAPTISM CLASSES

Parents are you expecting a baby? Have you thought about planning your baby's Baptism? Have you any children you want baptized? The next class will be on Friday, June 28th, in the Junipero Serra Room in the Pastoral Center. Pre-Baptism Classes are usually offered on the 4th Friday of each month from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Stop by the Pastoral Center



to obtain the necessary forms that are required for each person attending the class. Two months notice is requested for Baptism. You must have the yellow Baptismal Registration form stamped with the parish seal for admission to the Sacrament of Baptism. Baptisms are scheduled by appointment only. APPRECIATING THE EUCHARIST

For centuries today's feast was called Corpus Christi (the Body of Christ) and was observed on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. In many countries it has now been moved to Sunday, so that more people may participate in its celebration. In its present form, the liturgy of this day focuses our attention on the meaning of the Eucharist that we celebrate so often.

Today's reading from Genesis tells how "Melchizedek, king of Salem, brought out bread and wine" and prayed over Abram. Though it took place nearly two thousand years before Jesus, this event has long been used by the Church as an ancient foreshadowing of the Eucharist.

The reading from Paul's Letter to the Corinthians is the same one we hear proclaimed on Holy Thursday, retelling the story of the first blessing and sharing of bread and wine at the Last Supper. Luke's tale of the miraculous feeding of the crowd in today's Gospel is also clearly intended to evoke the Eucharist. Thus today's readings give us three opportunities to deepen our appreciation of the Body and Blood of

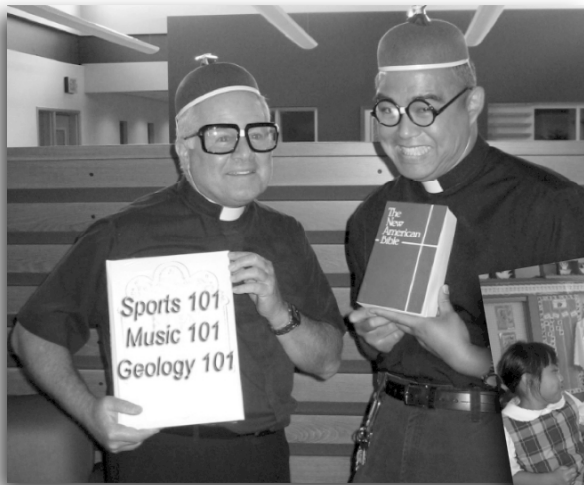

AÑO DE LA FE

La semana pasada hemos iniciado con el artículo sobre el Bautismo, que nos marca para siempre como pertenencia de Dios, es por eso que el Bautismo no puede ser repetido (CIC 1272). Esto significa que solamente una persona que no está bautizada puede ser bautizada. El Bautismo es válido cuando se hace con las palabras “Yo te bautizo en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo,” y si ministro tiene la misma intención de la Iglesia al realizar el bautismo. Hay casos en los que si el bautismo realizado está en duda, entonces se bautiza a la persona, añadiendo a la formula Trinitaria: “si no estás bautizado...”

Cada bautismo requiere el uso de agua, esto es porque acompaña aspectos de nuestra vida, el agua es necesaria para vivir y para la limpieza. Esto nos hace traer a la memoria también lo que Jesús dijo en Juan 3:5, “nadie puede entrar al Reino de Dios, sin no nace del agua y del Espíritu.”

El ministro ordinario para realizar el Bautismo es el Obispo, Sacerdote o Diácono. Pero en caso de emergencia, cualquier persona puede bautizar siempre y cuando tenga la intención de la Iglesia y ponga agua natural sobre la cabeza del candidato mientras dice la formula Trinitaria del Bautismo, invocando al Padre, y al Hijo, y al Espíritu Santo (CIC 1284)

De acuerdo con el Derecho Canónico número 873, “Tengase un solo padrino o una sola madrina, o uno y una”. El padrino o madrina es alguien que tiene que tener 16 años cumplidos y tenga la responsabilidad de ayudar a los padres en el cuidado y crecimiento de la fe de los nuevos bautizados. Por esta razón, El padrino o madrina, debe de tener todos los sacramentos de iniciación (Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía) y vivir de acuerdo con las enseñanzas de la Iglesia (CDC 874) para que el padrino o madrina, con su buen ejemplo de vida puedan consolidar lo mejor posible la fe de sus ahijados

El verano trae varias cosas que afectan su habilidad de proteger a sus hijos del abuso sexual. INFORMACIÓN SOBRE ABUSO DOMÉSTICO A PERSONAS QUE NO CUENTAN CON DOCUMENTACION LEGAL. PLAN PASTORAL PARROQUIAL

Nuestra Parroquia del Perpetuo Socorro, está ahora poniendo en práctica lo que hemos escrito en nuestro Plan Pastoral Parroquial, por lo que atendiendo al Pilar #4 Servicio, la visión 2, meta #3 que nos invita a mantener informada sobre cuestiones espirituales, sociales y morales; compartimos contigo esta información importante:

El abuso doméstico, se vive en la mayoría de los casos, en miedo y silencio, sobre todo cuando la persona que lo está viviendo piensa que no tiene derechos por no contar con documentos legales para vivir en este país.

El abuso domestico puede vivirse en diversas formas: físico, sexual y/o emocional, este afecta en su mayoría a mujeres más que a hombres. Aquí en los Estados Unidos afecta a miles de mujeres, las victimas creen que no pueden escapar de esta situación de abuso porque no cuentan con derechos, porque creen que no tienen voz por no tener documentos legales. Sin embargo es importante que sepan que tienen derecho y que su voz puede ser escuchada por las autoridades correspondientes.

Las mujeres que sufren de abuso domestico, deben saber que esté es un delito, y que la ley protegerá sus derechos, sea cual sea su situación migratoria. La “**Ley de Violencia contra las Mujeres**” (VAWA: **Vionlence Against Women Act**) da protección especial a víctimas de un esposo abusivo que es residente permanente o tiene la nacionalidad de los Estados Unidos, de modo que «una esposa abusada puede solicitar la residencia, sin importar como haya entrado al país. Las victimas que no están casadas con un ciudadano o residente permanente de los Estados Unidos, pueden cumplir con los requisitos para una visa U. Siempre y cuando haya reportado el hecho a las autoridades correspondientes.» (Cfr. vawa)
