THE YEAR OF FAITH



YEAR OF FAITH 2012-2013

The “reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For ‘by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and

deed” (CCC 1285).

This description of Confirmation reminds us of the way that the sacrament “confirms” our baptism into Christ. Confirmation places a seal on us, marking us as belonging to God, and therefore, being set apart from the world to be in his service and to receive His divine protection at the Last Judgment (CCC 1296). In a very real sense, the sacrament confirms our dedication to be true disciples of Christ and “gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross” (CCC 1303).

A candidate for Confirmation is someone who is already baptized, has not yet been confirmed, and has reached the “age of reason,” which is understood as completing seven years. (However, the conference of bishops can determine another suitable age.) The candidate must complete the necessary teachings, must desire to be confirmed, be prepared to assume the role of a Christian disciple, and be able to recite the baptismal promises. Only one sponsor is needed for this sacrament, and it is fitting for it to be one of the godparents from baptism. Through prayer, the laying on of hands, and anointing with sacred chrism, the bishop, or in some cases a priest, confirms the candidate with the words, “Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.”

Bullying Is a Form of Abuse

Did you know that bullying is a form of abuse, and therefore is forbidden in our Catholic schools? Bullying typically consists of direct behaviors, such as teasing, taunting, threatening, hitting, shoving and stealing. But it might also be indirect, such as spreading rumors that cause victims to be socially isolated through intentional exclusion. Cyberbullying, which involves the use of the Internet or mobile phones to send inappropriate messages and images to or about others, is also behavior that is not tolerated in our Catholic schools. FAMILY PROMISE'S 2nd ANNIVERSARY

In the past 2 years we have assisted 23 homeless families with shelter, meals, and supportive services for a total of 72 people, of which 44 were children under the age of 18. 73% of the families we have accepted in our program "graduated" successfully into transitional or permanent housing. We also helped an additional 9 families with supportive services only. Currently we are assisting 3 families; 4 adults and 4 children.

I enjoyed meeting many of you at our recent Ministry Fair, and a BIG Thank You to those who signed up as new volunteers. Help is always needed in preparing meals for our families, being an Evening Host, an Overnight Host and in assisting at the Resource Center in Canyon Country. Primer lugar: Ciudad del Señor, capitaneado por el Sr. Michael Ladisa.

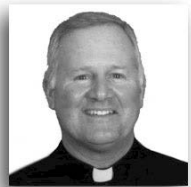
Segundo lugar; Academia de los Cacahuates, capitaneado por el Sr. Hilmar Rosenast.

El tema será: **LA VERDADERA FAMILIA DE JESÚS**

PLAN PASTORAL PARROQUIAL

Nuestra Parroquia del Perpetuo Socorro, está ahora poniendo en práctica lo que hemos escrito en **nuestro Plan Pastoral Parroquial, por lo que atendiendo al Pilar #4 Servicio, la visión 2, meta #3** que nos invita a mantener informada sobre cuestiones espirituales, sociales y morales; compartimos contigo esta información importante:

...(continuación) Víctimas de Violencia Doméstica y Migración.

Como compartimos en el artículo anterior, las víctimas de violencia doméstica que no cuentan con documentos legales en este país, pueden aplicar para una visa U.

El proceso para acogerse a la **ley VAWA** comienza cuando la víctima presenta una solicitud formal al Servicio de Inmigración, el cual determinará si reúne o no las condiciones requeridas antes de contemplar la solicitud minuciosamente. Este proceso se llama establecimiento de "Prima Facie", el cual:

- Detiene cualquier proceso de remoción en contra de la víctima en la corte de inmigración.
- Detiene cualquier orden final de deportación en contra de la víctima (debe presentarse una solicitud en la corte para reabrir el caso).
- La hace elegible para un Permiso de Empleo.
- La hace elegible para recibir ayuda y otros servicios del gobierno.
- Hace que los hijos menores de la víctima, presentes en el país reciban beneficios derivativos. (para este propósito, se considera menor de edad a un hijo menor de 21 años).

Para poder acogerse a la ley, el solicitante debe ser mayor de 21 años y tiene que demostrar que:

- Es ó fue víctima de abuso físico o crueldad extrema en manos de su cónyuge durante el matrimonio.
- Su cónyuge es ciudadano estadounidense o residente permanente.
- Esta o estuvo casada hace menos de dos años.
- El matrimonio es o fue legítimo y no para propósitos de fraude de inmigración, (la convivencia de unión libre también es válida, en el caso de que fuera válida donde residía la pareja.)
- Vivía con el cónyuge.
- Posee un carácter moral adecuado o sea no tener historial criminal.

Es importante que realices tu denuncia, te asesores legalmente, **pero sobre todo que reconozcas que eres un Ser Humano que merece ser tratado con dignidad y respeto.**

AÑO DE LA FE

La «recepción del sacramento de Confirmación es necesario para completar la gracia del bautismo. A través del sacramento de la Confirmación, (el bautizado) se une más íntimamente a la Iglesia y los enriquece con una fortaleza especial del Espíritu Santo. Por lo tanto, están, como verdaderos testigos de Cristo, mas estrictamente obligados a difundir y defender la fe con sus palabras y sus obras» (CIC 1285).



Esta descripción del sacramento de la Confirmación nos recuerda la forma en que el sacramento "confirma" nuestro bautismo en Cristo. En la Confirmación "el sello del Espíritu Santo marca la pertenencia total a Cristo, la puesta a su servicio para siempre, pero indica también la promesa de la protección divina en la gran prueba escatológica (CIC 1296). En el sentido más profundo, el Sacramento confirma nuestra dedicación para ser verdaderos discípulos de Cristo y «nos concede una fuerza especial del Espíritu Santo para difundir y defender la fe mediante la palabra y las obras como verdaderos testigos de Cristo, para confesar valientemente el nombre de Cristo y para no sentir jamás vergüenza de la Cruz» (CIC 1303).

Un candidato para la Confirmación es alguien que ya ha sido bautizado, que aun no ha sido confirmado y ha alcanzado la "edad de la razón," que es al menos siete años. (Sin embargo, la conferencia Episcopal puede determinar otra edad conveniente). El candidato debe completar las enseñanzas necesarias, debe desear confirmarse, estar preparado para asumir el papel de un discípulo de Cristo, y ser capaz de recitar las promesas bautismales. Para este sacramento solamente es necesario un padrino o madrina, lo más conveniente es que sea uno de los padrinos del bautismo. A través de la oración, la imposición de las manos y la unción con el Santo Crisma, el obispo o en algunos casos un sacerdote designado por el obispo, confirma al candidato con las siguientes palabras: "Recibe por esta señal el don del Espíritu Santo."

Pueden leer y aprender más sobre el Sacramento de la Confirmación en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC) en los numerales 1285-1321.

Si usted sospecha que algun estudiante es victima de hostigamiento, inmediatamente comuniquese sus preocupaciones al director de la escuela. 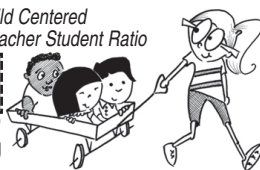

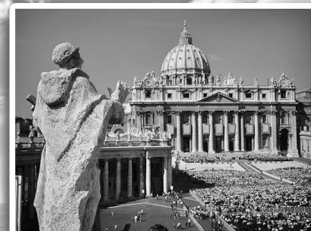
