Dear Parishioners:



THE YEAR OF FAITH

The Eucharist, also known as Holy Communion, is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (CCC 1324) because the Eucharist is Christ himself, his Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. It is the true presence of Christ our Lord.



YEAR OF FAITH²⁰¹³


It is the source of the Christian life because it is through Christ that we have come to faith and our relationship with God. It is also the way that Christ strengthens us to live our lives in accordance with his commandments. It is from communion with this source that we can receive the nourishment to live our lives as disciples of Christ.

It is the summit of the Christian life because it is "the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit" (CCC 1325). In other words, the celebration of the Eucharist, which is the Mass, brings us into worship of Christ "by uniting ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and anticipate eternal life, when God will be all in all" (CCC 1326). There is nothing greater that anyone can attain than when we are united to the love of Christ who gave himself for us on the cross. And when we are united to Christ through receiving Holy Communion, we are increasingly being transformed into the Body of Christ, the Church.

Because the Eucharist is so central to our faith, we will discuss this further for the next two weeks. In the meantime, you can learn more about the sacrament of the Eucharist in the Catechism of the Catholic Church nos. 1322-1419.

PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION

La Eucaristía, también conocida como Sagrada Comunión, es «la fuente y cima de toda la vida cristiana» (CIC 1324) porque la Eucaristía es el mismo Cristo, su Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad. Es la verdadera presencia de Cristo nuestro Señor.

Es la fuente de la vida cristiana porque es a través de Cristo como hemos llegado a la fe y a una relación con Dios. También es la forma en que Cristo nos fortalece para vivir de acuerdo a sus mandamientos. Es la comunión con esta fuente que podemos recibir el alimento para vivir como verdaderos discípulos de Cristo.

Es la fuente de la vida Cristiana porque "en ella se encuentra a la vez la cumbre de la acción por la que, en Cristo, Dios santifica al mundo, y del culto que en el Espíritu Santo los hombres dan a Cristo y por él al Padre" (CIC 1325). En otras palabras, la celebración de la Eucaristía, que celebramos en la Misa, nos lleva a la alabanza de Cristo, ya que por ella «nos unimos ya a la liturgia del cielo y anticipamos la vida eterna cuando será todo en todos».
