## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners:

I celebrated my 33<sup>rd</sup> anniversary as a priest some ten days ago on June 21. It slipped by relatively unnoticed and without fanfare, although the Archbishop presented me with an exciting prospect. He informed me that I may take a sabbatical.

Archdiocesan priests may depart for sabbatical every 7 years. But in my 33 years as a priest I have yet to go on one. It seemed to me that there had never been an opportune time to get away, so I am more than overdue for a period of renewal. Well, let me just say that it is time! I look forward to a period of renewal to refresh my soul and priestly zeal.

The length of sabbatical is 4 months. My body may be away from the parish during those months, but my spirit will be very much with each of you. You are in my heart.

The Archdiocese has assigned Fr. Alberto Avenido to fill in for me while I am away. With the collaboration of both the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, he will manage the many decisions that will need to be made on behalf of the pastoral ministry at OLPH.

The parish is in a good place. Our capital campaign is under way. We have a fine leadership committee who will guide the campaign through the completion of the "Let's Hit 300" drive. Preparations for our Annual Barbecue in September are progressing nicely. Our new music and liturgy director will have begun by the time I return. And we have a pastoral plan that my pastoral staff will continue to implement during my absence.

Part of my sabbatical will be a 30-day silent, directed Ignatian retreat. I made one early in my priesthood and found it very energizing and helpful. I look forward to making this one as I wonder what the Lord will have in store for me as I deepen my friendship with Him.

### THE YEAR OF FAITH

In this last of three articles on the Eucharist we'll take a look at communion under each species (bread and wine) and a grace of the Eucharist.

Christ (Body, Blood, soul, and divinity) is sacramentally present under each species of the Eucharist, so it is possible to receive fully the Eucharistic grace by receiving under only the species of bread. However, receiving under both species makes the sign of communion more complete because it makes the sign of the Eucharistic meal (Last Supper) appear more clearly. (CCC 1390)



YEAR OF FAITH 2012

It is important to emphasize that Christ is fully present under each of the species of bread and wine. When you receive communion under the species of bread, you receive the Body and Blood, soul and divinity of Christ. When you receive under the species of wine, you receive the Body and Blood, soul and divinity of Christ. Even though you hear the words "the Body of Christ" or "the Blood of Christ," you still receive Christ fully in each species. Communion under each species is presented to you in the same way (wording and order) as at the Last Supper.

One of the graces of Holy Communion is that it separates us from sin. Because it unites us to Christ, it can cleanse us from past venial sins (CCC 1394) and can preserve us from future mortal sins (CCC 1395) because the more that we are in communion with Christ, the harder it will be for us to willingly break away from him by committing mortal sin. However, the Eucharist is "properly the sacrament of those who are in full communion with the Church" (CCC 1395) and those who find themselves in the state of mortal sin must first celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving the Eucharist.

Beginning next week we will look at the sacraments of healing.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION INFORMATION FOR 2013—2014

The Religious Education Office is currently closed and will reopen on August 19th. At that time we will be accepting registrations for all families with students in



grades 1 through 8 for continuing religious education including 1<sup>st</sup> Communion preparation. Classes will begin the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September and the cost is \$100 per student for elementary and \$110 for Jr. High students (7<sup>th</sup> / 8<sup>th</sup> grades). Our classes take place during the weekdays on Mondays, Tuesdays, or Thursdays from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m. or 5:45 to 7:15 p.m. depending on your student's grade in the fall.

#### Playing It Safe When the Heat Is On

Most people who hold positions of trust in Catholic institutions are mandated by California state law to report

child abuse. Teachers, teacher's aides and counselors in our schools, therapists and social workers in our counseling agencies, nurses and doctors in hospitals, and clergy in parishes or other ministries all have the obligation to report the reasonable suspicion of child abuse to the local police or to child protective services. When any of

these people know of or have reasonable suspicion of abuse, they report it to the appropriate police or protective agency. This is true for those ministering in facilities owned and operated by the Archdiocese, as well as Catholic institutions owned and operated privately by religious communities. ### AÑO DE LA FE

Este es el último de los tres artículos sobre la Eucaristía, en este espacio, daremos una mirada a la comunión bajo las dos especies (pan y vino) y a la gracia de la Eucaristía.



Cristo (Cuerpo, Sangre, alma y divinidad) está sacramentalmente presente bajo cada una de las especies de la Eucaristía, así que es posible recibir completamente la gracia de la Eucaristía cuando la recibimos solo bajo la especie del pan. Sin embargo recibir la comunión bajo ambas especies, hace el signo de comunión más completa porque es el signo de la mesa Eucarística (la ultima Cena) está más claramente en CIC1390.

Es importante enfatizar que Cristo está completamente presente bajo cada una de las especies del pan y del vino. Cuando recibimos la comunión bajo la especie del pan, estamos recibiendo el Cuerpo y Sangre, alma y divinidad de Cristo. Cuando recibimos la comunión bajo la especie del vino, estamos recibiendo el Cuerpo, Sangre, alma y divinidad de Cristo. Aun cuando oigas las palabras “el Cuerpo de Cristo” o “la Sangre de Cristo”, seguimos recibiendo plenamente a Cristo en cada una de las especies. La comunión bajo cada una de las especies no presenta la misma forma (expresión y orden) que en la última cena.

Una de las gracias de la Sagrada Comunión es que nos separa del pecado. Porque nos une a Cristo, que limpia de nosotros todo pecado venial (CIC 1394) y nos preserva en el futuro del pecado mortal (CIC 1395) porque mientras más estemos en comunión con Cristo, mas difícil será para nosotros romper voluntariamente con Él por haber cometido pecado mortal. Sin embargo, la Eucaristía es “sacramento de los que están en plena comunión con la Iglesia” (CIC 1395) y los que están en pecado mortal deben primero celebrar el Sacramento de la Reconciliación antes de recibir la Eucaristía.

Iniciando la próxima semana vamos a reflexionar sobre los sacramentos de sanación.

Pueden leer y aprender más sobre el sacramento de la Eucaristía en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica en los números 1322-1419.




