My goal during my few months at OLPH is to support the daily life of the parish and to assure the continued implementation of your Pastoral Plan. To accomplish this goal I will rely on your prayers, support and leadership of numerous individuals.

As part of an administrative reorganization planned by Msgr. Martini there are several paid office positions that will be eliminated but please join me in welcoming two new paid positions, a Director of Music & Liturgy and a landscape maintenance person. Mr. Ed Archer has been hired as our new Director of Music & Liturgy and will begin working with us in mid-August. Ed joins us after serving many years at St. Monica Church in Santa Monica. Our search for a landscape maintenance person is in-process.

I am already very grateful being a part of this wonderful parish community and I can see that the Holy Spirit is very much present here. With firm faith, I look forward to the days ahead.

THE YEAR OF FAITH

The two Sacraments of Healing are (1) Penance and Reconciliation and (2) Anointing of the Sick. For the next two weeks we will focus on Penance and Reconciliation.

Sin is an offense against God and a break in communion with Him. At the same time it breaks communion with the Church, the People of God, because when we sin we sin against a human person. For this reason conversion includes seeking God's forgiveness and seeking reconciliation with the Church (CCC 1440).



YEAR OF FAITH 2012-2013

Many people do not like the idea of having to go to a priest to confess their sins for a multitude of reasons, chiefly among them is embarrassment of admitting one's faults to another person. However, God provides us much grace when we approach Him through His minister, who is there to show us God's mercy.

This sacrament is called the sacrament of "confession" because we disclose, or confess, our sins to a priest. It is also a confession, in the sense of acknowledgment, because we acknowledge God's mercy toward us sinners when we seek His pardon.

It is also called the sacrament of "forgiveness" because through the priest's absolution God grants to the penitent His pardon and peace.

It is called the sacrament of "reconciliation" because it gives to the penitent the love of God who places us back in a right relationship with Him and causes us to strive to be in a right relationship with our brothers and sisters.

Next week we will look at how to celebrate the sacrament of penance and reconciliation. In the meantime, to find out more about this sacrament read in the Catechism of the Catholic Church nos. 1420-1498.

Recently, Bill Moyers interviewed the producers of a documentary "A Place at the Table". They discussed the faces of America's poor today. Who are they? We think of the homeless and those who cannot find a job over a long period of time. Many of poor are indeed in these situations; however, we often forget about the working poor. There are hard working people, parents often with two income sources, who cannot afford the basic necessities for their families. There are skilled people who had their work hours reduced to the point that they need to go to a food pantry to have enough food for the family. There are families in Santa Clarita living in nice neighborhoods who are struggling to have enough food on the table. They need help with basic necessities such as utilities, water, toiletries and the like. They are months in arrears with their mortgages. Eviction is looming on the horizon for many of them.

These are families who could afford their homes and provide the necessities for their families but have now fallen on hard times for various reasons. They never before had to look for help. They don't know the "ropes" of getting benefits from Social Services. It never dawned on them to ask or depend on others. And they are our neighbors, quite literally, the neighbor next door!

There are not enough organizations and charities in our community to help with rents and utilities. Requests are generally referred to St. Vincent de Paul.

INFORMATION FOR 2013—2014**

The Religious Education Office is currently closed and will reopen on August 19th. At that time we will be accepting registrations for all families with students in



grades 1 through 8 for continuing religious education including 1st Communion preparation. Classes will begin the 3rd week of September and the cost is \$100 per student for elementary and \$110 for Jr. High students (7th / 8th grades). You must be a registered member of our parish and bring a copy of your child's Baptism certificate to register for classes.

We will not accept registration for 1st graders without a copy of their Baptism certificate (if they have been Baptized).





AÑO DE LA FE

Sin embargo, Dios nos proporciona su gracia en abundancia cuando nos acercamos a través de su ministro, que está ahí para mostrarnos la misericordia de Dios.

Este sacramento es llamado el sacramento de la “confesión” porque revelamos, o confesamos nuestros pecados al sacerdote. Es también una confesión, en el sentido de reconocimiento, porque reconocemos la misericordia de Dios para con nosotros pecadores y buscamos su perdón.

Es también llamado sacramento del “perdón” porque a través de la absolución del sacerdote Dios nos brinda la penitencia, su perdón y la paz.

Se llama Sacramento de la “reconciliación” porque da al penitente el amor de Dios, que nos pone en una relación correcta con Él y con los hermanos y hermanas.

La próxima semana, podremos ver como celebrar el sacramento de la penitencia y reconciliación. Durante este tiempo pueden buscar más información, leyendo el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica números 1420-1498.
