

CLERGY CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

During the week of Aug. 4, 2013, you may have heard news reports about a “mystery priest” who appeared on the scene of a horrible car collision near Center, Missouri. Katie Lentz, a nineteen-year-old driver, was pinned down in her car and asked rescue workers to pray with her. At that point the New London fire fighters with her met a man dressed as a Catholic priest who anointed Katie and brought a sense of calmness to the whole scene. That priest then told the rescue workers to remain calm and that their equipment would work fine, even though they were having difficulty with their equipment. Immediately after saying this, more rescue workers arrived with fresh equipment. Katie was freed and survived, but the priest was nowhere to be found. A friend of Katie said that he wasn’t sure if it was an angel appearing as a priest, or a priest being an angel, but he was definitely an angel to everyone there. Incidentally, that priest was Rev. Patrick Dowling of the Diocese of Jefferson County.

I’ve heard people commenting before that they haven’t seen God doing great things like he did in the Bible. I would suggest that we open our eyes and see just how God is doing those great things to this day. We get so caught up in our own plans and seem to have tunnel vision when God does something in our lives. Let’s take a moment to recognize how God is doing great things in our lives and in the world, just like in the Bible. We don’t hear a lot about it. The news doesn’t really share a lot of these stories. But we have ways of sharing our own stories with others. I encourage you to look for those stories in your own lives and to share them with people, either through conversations, testimonies, or through Facebook and/or Twitter posts. Let’s see if we can bring hope and awareness of God’s presence to people’s lives.

THE YEAR OF FAITH

The second degree of the sacrament of Holy Orders, the presbyterate (priest), is a ministerial participation in the priesthood of Christ that is aimed at assisting the bishops. Priests are meant to be the co-workers of the bishops with regard to preaching the Gospel, shepherding the faithful, and celebrating divine worship (*CCC* 1564).

Everything that a priest does must be aimed at bringing Christ to the world. Most of what you see priests do involve celebrating the sacraments (i.e., baptizing, celebrating the Eucharist, absolving sins, witnessing marriages, anointing the sick, and sometimes celebrating Confirmations). But the less public responsibilities of priests would involve providing spiritual direction, pastoral counseling, giving blessings, and personal and intercessory prayer. Some of the more public responsibilities could involve parish administration, teaching, leading retreats, school ministry, hospital ministry, ministry to the incarcerated, etc.

Generally, the responsibilities of the priest center on sanctification (making holy), teaching, and worship. All of these responsibilities are at the service of the People of God to help them to know God's love for them through various ways and to help them to grow as Christ's disciples, journeying with them along the way as a shepherd tends his flock. In other words, the priest must carry out his ministry by following Christ, who gave his life for the Church, so that she may be holy (set apart for God).

Next week we will look at the third degree of Holy Orders: the diaconate.

BECOMING CATHOLIC AT OLPH

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process of reflection, prayer, instruction, discernment and formation for adults and older children interested in the Catholic faith and Christian living. This process is the inspiring model used by the early Christians to bring others into the Church.

Our focus is to nurture the conversion in the hearts and lives of all who enter into the program. Using prayer, catechesis and scripture study, we walk with you on your journey of faith. And with the community, you will embrace Christ through the Sacramental life of the Church.

Any Catholic in need of completing their Sacraments may also enter the program. If you are ready to make the first step, join in on weekly sessions and begin the Inquiry phase of the program. Volunteers, fully initiated in the faith, are also welcomed and encouraged to get involved in the program.

RITE OF INITIATION FOR CHILDREN

Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) will begin a children's catechumenate in September. The children's catechumenate will be for school age children (1st grade through 12th grade) who have not been baptized and need to complete all of their sacraments.

The catechumenate is also for youth between 8th grade and 12th grade who have been baptized but need to complete their sacraments of initiation (Holy Communion and Confirmation).

Anyone who is 17 years of age or older is encouraged to join the adult initiation program.

The children's catechumenate is a two year process and all sacraments will be completed. The program is now forming, and it is wonderful opportunity for your child to be part of a new program and build a lifelong relationship with the Lord. RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR 2013—2014

The Religious Education Office will reopen tomorrow, **August 19th**. Our office hours will be Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 3:00 to 7:00 p.m. We will be accepting

 registrations for all families with students in grades 1 through 8 for continuing religious education including 1st Communion preparation. Classes will begin the 3rd week of September and the cost is \$100 per student for elementary and \$110 for Jr.

High students (7th / 8th grades). Our classes take place during the weekdays on Mondays, Tuesdays, or Thursdays from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m. or 5:45 to 7:15 p.m. depending on your student's grade in the fall.

You must be a registered member of our parish and bring a copy of your child's Baptism certificate to register for classes.

We will not accept registration for 1st graders without a copy of their Baptism certificate (if they have been Baptized).

DID YOU KNOW?

Internet Filter Software Is No Substitute for Parental Monitoring

There is a lot of material on the Internet that is inappropriate for children. Parents can use filtering software to protect children from that material, but filters do not guarantee that children will not be exposed; a filter will never be a substitute for parents' presence. Monitor your child's online behavior. Keep your family computer in a highly visible, common area, like the family room or the kitchen. Ask your children to show you what sites they go to, and be open and willing to discuss the inappropriate material they might come across. Los tres grados del Sacramento de Ordenes Sagradas son el episcopado (obispo), presbítero (sacerdote), y diaconado (diácono). Los primeros dos grados (episcopado y presbítero) son participaciones ministeriales del sacerdocio de Cristo, mientras que el tercer grado (diaconado) está destinado a ayudar a los sacerdotes y dedicado al servicio de los demás.

El episcopado es la plenitud del sacramento de las Ordenes Sagradas (CIC 1557). Es una sucesión apostólica donde el obispo está encargado de la pastoral de una iglesia particular, igual que los apóstoles. En este cuidado pastoral de su Iglesia particular (es decir diócesis o Arquidiócesis, que es un grupo de parroquias de una región determinada) el obispo tiene la responsabilidad de santificar, enseñar y gobernar los asuntos de su región.

A través del episcopado, cada obispo comparte colegialmente la responsabilidad de la pastoral en conjunto de la Iglesia universal, y asegura la continuidad de la misión apostólica de la Iglesia la evangelización. Algunos de los sacramentos que, normalmente, sólo los obispos confieren, son las ordenaciones y confirmaciones, el diaconado y la de presbítero. Para una ordenación episcopal se requieren varios obispos.
