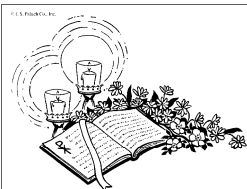
Dear Parishioners:

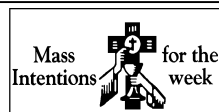

THE YEAR OF FAITH

Why do we not kneel after receiving Communion anymore?

Prior to Advent 1999, the normal practice in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles for the faithful after receiving Holy Communion was to kneel down for a period of silent prayer. But due to a Pastoral Letter entitled *Gather Faithfully Together: Guide for Sunday Mass*, which was written by Cardinal Mahony, that practice changed to the faithful standing until all have received Holy Communion. While they are standing, the faithful join together in singing the Communion song. This was the same document that gave the instruction for the Communion procession to begin from the back of the church.

Each diocesan bishop has the authority to issue liturgical norms within his diocese, and Archbishop Gomez informed the priests of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles that we will continue to follow the norms found in *Gather Faithfully Together*.

So within the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, the normal practice after receiving Holy Communion is to remain standing and to join in the Communion song. Once everyone has received Communion, the faithful then sit down and pray to the Lord in silence. This is the normal way in the whole archdiocese, but it is only a practice that we have here, not in other dioceses. A good rule to follow regarding sitting, kneeling, or standing after receiving Communion is to watch what majority of the faithful do. But regardless of which posture you take, your interior should be focused on that communion you now have with our Lord.

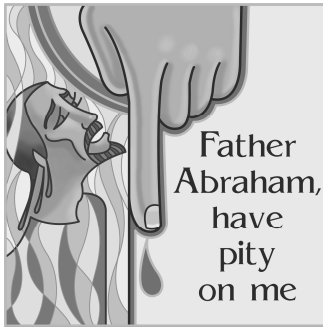

The final two days for late registration are this Tuesday, **October 1st**, and Thursday, **October 3rd**. After that, all students who register late will be placed in our home study program for the year.

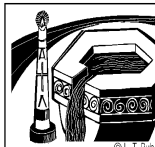

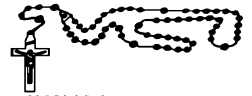
Friday, October 25th, in the Junipero Serra Room in the new Pastoral Center.

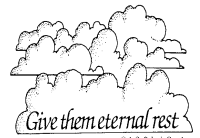

AÑO DE LA FE

¿Por qué ya no nos arrodillamos después de que recibimos la Comunión?

Antes del Adviento 1999, la práctica habitual, en la Arquidiócesis de los Ángeles para los fieles tras recibir la Sagrada Comunión nos debíamos arrodillar por un periodo de silencio. Pero debido a una carta Pastoral titulada **“Reúnanse fielmente en la Asamblea”**: *Guía para la Misa Dominical*, que fue escrita por el Cardenal Mahony, la práctica de arrodillarse cambió y ahora nos quedarnos de pie hasta que la todos hayamos recibido la Sagrada Comunión. Mientras estamos de pie, los fieles nos unimos al canto de Comunión. En el mismo documento se nos ha dado la instrucción de que la procesión de Comunión inicie de la parte de atrás de la iglesia hacia enfrente.

Cada obispo diocesano tiene la autoridad de emitir normas litúrgicas dentro de su diócesis, y el arzobispo Gómez informó a los sacerdotes de la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles que continuaremos las normas que tenemos en la carta pastoral *Reúnanse fielmente en la Asamblea*.

Así que dentro de la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles, la práctica normal después de recibir la Santa Comunión es permanecer de pie y participar en el canto de comunión. Una vez que todos han recibido la Comunión, los fieles en la asamblea se sientan y orar en silencio al Señor. Esta es la forma común en toda la arquidiócesis, pero es solamente una práctica que tenemos aquí, no en otras diócesis. Una buena regla a seguir en otras diócesis, es observar lo que la mayoría de la gente hace después de recibir la Comunión, si se arrodillan, se quedan de pie o se sientan. Pero sin importar que postura se tome, nuestro interior debe estar centrado en la Comunión que ahora y a partir de ese momento tienes con nuestro Señor.



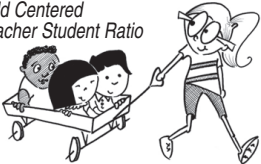
