THE YEAR OF FAITH

Is Pope Francis changing Church teachings?

The simple answer is an emphatic “NO.” The pope is not changing Church teaching. In fact, he’s actually reiterating what the Church has taught for quite some time.



Following the spirit of Vatican II, which encouraged a return to the sources for deeper understanding, Pope Francis has been reminding us of what is at the heart of the Church’s official teachings on various issues. This also follows the exhortations of Jesus and St. Paul to pay attention to the spirit of the law instead of only the letter of the law. The only change that the pope is actually calling for is the further development of our understanding of what God has already revealed to us. He’s calling US to change.

In his famous interview, Pope Francis spoke candidly about such things as his life, his spirituality, and his views of what is needed in the life of the Church, the People of God. However, the mainstream media would often emphasize certain things he says and place them out of their context, resulting in a skewed version of what he actually said. When something is taken out of context, you would often hear the phrase, “In a departure from [previous popes, Church teaching, etc.]”

I encourage all of you to go to the source of the interview and read it yourselves, rather than just be satisfied with what the news reports on it. That way, you can read what was actually said and understand it in its proper context. This will help with understanding the spirit of the interview, rather than just the letter of the interview. It will give you the big picture, rather than just what some people want to emphasize.



Daycare Centers, Nurseries, Schools Should Have Open Door Policies

Parents and guardians have the primary responsibility for protecting their children from all potential harm. When choosing a nursery, daycare center or school, parents should inspect the building and grounds to make sure there are no areas where children play or work that are "off limits" to parents. Such facilities should have a policy that welcomes parents to visit the center or school without prior appointment.



THE TRUTH ABOUT CATHOLIC ANNULMENT

The annulment process is often shrouded by myths and misunderstandings. This experience, which allows divorced Catholics to seek healing and the freedom to remarry in the Church, is also a source of confusion among many Catholics.


